



#### Haiti

Haiti is a fourth-world country, among the last in the world ranking for the conditions of childhood, mortality and destitution.

It is a little bigger than Lombardy and has almost 9 million inhabitants.

The official language is Creole / French.

- 1 child in 3 dies before 5 years of malnutrition and treatable diseases;
- 80% of the population live on less than 1 dollar a day;
- 1 child out of 2 does not go to school;
- the average life expectancy does not exceed 55 years;
- 70% of the population has no work.

January 2010: a terrible earthquake causes 230,000, 300,000 injured and 1 million homeless people. Today the country has not yet risen from the catastrophe.

Meanwhile, he was hit by cholera and two hurricanes.

There are no infrastructures, sewage and electrical systems, public hospitals are absent or in absolutely degraded conditions.





#### NPH's project in Haiti

**NPH has been present in Haiti since 1987** under the guidance of the doctor at the forefront of Father Rick Frechette with a series of projects in the field of health, education, reception for orphans or in desperate need, all supported by the **Francesca Rava Foundation - NPH Italy .** 

- 3 **hospitals** including the Saint Luc Hospital with the adjoining center for cholera Santa Filomena,
- 2 rehabilitation centers for disabled children
- 32 street schools supplying food and education to 10,000 children
- 3 **orphanages** that welcome 780 orphans in desperate need
- the Fors Lakay reconstruction project with 200 houses, Internet Center (already built 3 of 6), a bakery, the Saint Mary hospital,
- **distribution of pasta, rice, water** (over 1700 truck-tanks per year) in the poorest neighborhoods: cité soleil (biggest slum in the world)
- funerals for thousands of abandoned bodies or whose loved ones are too poor for a dignified burial.





#### Typical day of the volunteer

- > h. 7: Mass by Father Rick (optional at the hospital chapel 2min by car from Villa Francesca)
- > h. 8: breakfast
- > h. 9: activities with the children of the baby house and kay st simon, of the hospital, to help Father Rick
- > h. 13.30: lunch at Villa Francesca
- h. 14.45: activities with the children of the baby house and kay st simon, of the hospital, to help Father Rick
- > h. 18: return to Villa Francesca, rest and dinner.
- > h. 21: after dinner, relaxing and sharing moments


